Term 1 – The Cloud

- *Is just a synonym for the **Internet***
- **Cloud Storage**
online storage space
- **Cloud Computing**
*apps running from the Internet
(instead of your computer)*



Examples: DropBox & Google Drive

Term 2 – Social Networking

- **Internet services** that allow you to **connect** and then **interact** with others using your computer, smartphone, or tablet
 - **Facebook** – make “friends” and then read and share “posts” on your “newsfeed”.
 - **YouTube** – share videos with family, friends, the world
 - **Twitter** – send out (and read) 140 character micro-posts
 - **LinkedIn** – a Facebook-like service for business people
 - **Pinterest** – visually share interests by pinning images to “boards”

Term 3 – Twitter

- A **social networking** service that lets you share information via “**tweets**” (140 character phrases)
 - **Free** account sign-up
 - You “**follow**” those who interest you
 - You read tweets and interact
 - You can send your own tweets
 - Is great for “live” news and info

Term 4 – Bluetooth

- A **wireless** technology that lets you connect devices to accessories
 - Many mobile devices (smartphones and tablets) do not have normal “ports” or plugs for connecting
 - Instead, Bluetooth connections let those devices connect to
 - Printers
 - Keyboards
 - Speakers
 - Earbuds
 - Etc.

Term 5 – App

- Short for “**Application**”, is a new name for a **program** or **software**
 - **App** is commonly used for the programs we use on mobile devices (smartphones, tablets).
 - Starting with **Windows 10**, Microsoft now calls all programs/software, Apps.

Term 6 – Smart

- *“Smart” devices are those that can connect to the Internet*
 - *Smartphone* – a cellular phone that can also connect to the Internet for email, browsing, and cloud services
 - *Smart TV*– a normal television that can also connect to the Internet and run Apps that can display media.
 - *Smart Home* – a home equipped with devices that can be controlled remotely across the Internet



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Example: TV Remote & Apple TV

Term 7 – Digital Personal Assistants

- *Also called **Intelligent Personal Assistants***
- *Software on a device that can **help you** perform services or tasks, based upon your input, location, and access to the Internet*
- *Examples:*
 - *Siri* (Apple)
 - *Cortana* (Microsoft)
 - *Alexa* (Amazon)
 - *Google Now* (Google)
